Day trips, concerts and art venues

Ljubljana is the best starting point from which to explore Slovenia and from Ljubljana you may visit the Slovenia's most famous sights such as lake Bled, Postojna caves, lake Bohinj, coastal towns of Piran, Izola or Koper, Skocjan caves, Lipica stud-farm (founded in 1580) or discover its lesser-known corners such as Logar valley, Soča valley, Celje, Jezersko, Velika planina or Goriska brda..







Ljubljana's culture and music venues

Ljubljana is a European capital of culture, art, festivals and adventures with its own distinctive identity. It is famous for its vibrant cultural scene, contemporary creativity, quality of life, excellent cuisine and an atmosphere that's hard to forget.

See historic sights: Plečnik's Ljubljana – a unique example of urban planning that is among the most important "total" works of art of the twentieth century, Ljubljana Castle with its rich history dating back 900 years, the largest collection of Slovene art at the National Gallery, the oldest musical instrument in the world at the National Museum, and the world's oldest wooden wheel with axle at the City Museum of Ljubljana.

Experience authentic contact with the destination and discover a festival city – with experiences of lifestyle, customs, cuisine, folklore, street theatre and classical music. Festival events in the city centre begin each year with "June in Ljubljana," "Ljubljana Festival" and end with "Nights in Old Ljubljana" at the end of August. "Summer in Old Ljubljana" includes open-air jazz performances and early music concerts. For a few days each year, the Ana Desetnica International Street Theatre Festival transforms the streets of Ljubljana into a stage.

Set off to explore urban neighborhoods, street culture and avant-garde spaces and get to know the local population. Visit the Kino Šiška Centre of Urban Culture, the Cukrarna Gallery and Gallery of Modern Art. Stroll down Križevniška, one of Ljubljana's oldest streets, and visit the rich cultural, cuisine and crafts quarter known as Soteska. For music do check opera house of Ljubljana, Slovenian Philharmonic, Krizanke open air concerts and numerous other concert venues.
